TGIF Scratch Masters Tournament Rules

- 1. The TGIF Scratch Masters, in conjunction with the TGIF Classic 2009, is a mixed competition open to men and women by invitation only.
- 2. <u>The Tournament Directors may place a bowler in a higher division at their discretion.</u> <u>Any adjustments of this type will be made before the entrant bowls.</u> The six (6) game scratch total from the Team and Doubles events will be used to determine the eight (8) qualifiers and one (1) alternate for this competition. In case of a tie for 8th position, the scratch score from the first game of the Singles Event will determine the eighth place qualifier. Tournament scores will not carry over to the Scratch Masters Event.
- 3. The Scratch Masters event will be offered to all participants of the TGIF Classic using four (4) divisions. The divisions will be determined based on an average of the entering averages for the TGIF Classic and will be published at tournament registration. Entry fee for each division shall be as follows:
 - Division A: \$25 Division B: \$30 Division C: \$35 Division D: \$50
- 4. The eight (8) qualifiers in all divisions will bowl in a single elimination bracket style bowl off with the highest ranked bowler to choose the starting lane and the lower ranked bowler to start the match:

Bracket I: (pairing A) 1st place bowls 8th place; (pairing B) 4th place bowls 5th place Bracket II: (pairing C) 3rd place bowls 6th place; (pairing D) 2nd place bowls 7th place

The winners of pairing A and B will bowl each other to determine the winner of Bracket I.

The winners of pairing C and D will bowl each other to determine the winner of Bracket II.

The winner of Bracket I will bowl the winner of Bracket II to determine the winner of the Division.

- 5. In the event of a tie, an extra 9th and 10th frame roll-off will determine the winner of the match.
- 6. The games for all divisions will begin at 12:30pm on Sunday, July 5th, 2009 at Western Bowl. Participants must check in 30 minutes before the position match. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice on any of the eight (8) lanes that will be used before the first match only. No open bowling will be allowed prior to the Scratch Masters event.
- 7. A bowler who is not available to bowl at the scheduled time will be disqualified and the alternate will replace him/her.
- 8. Payout will be 100% less the lineage. The payoff will be 1 in 5 entries with a maximum of 8 places in each division.
- 9. Any claims of error must be reported before the start of the next match. In case of any claims of an error in the final match, the error must be reported within one (1) hour after the end of the match.



Tournament Rules for TGIF Classic

- 1. The 14th Annual Greater Indianapolis Fourth of July Classic (hereinafter referred to as TGIF Classic) will be held July 3-5 2009. Tournament participation is open to USBC members and nonmembers. Award recognition will be automatically extended to USBC members; nonmembers may qualify for USBC awards at their option by paying a \$5.00 participation fee. Tournament will be sanctioned by USBC as a Moral Support Tournament as defined in USBC rule 301a. By completing this application, each bowler or their representative indicates that they are a member or supporter of the International Gay Bowling Organization (IGBO) who pays the fee to become a member of IGBO. Any bowler holding PBA membership is ineligible for entry in the TGIF Classic.
- 2. TGIF Classic has competition in Singles, Doubles, Team, and All Events. The entry fee of \$90.00 covers participation in each event. Entries must be accompanied by full payment of fees. Personal checks will be accepted through May 30, 2009. The entry fee after May 30, 2009 is \$100.00 and must be remitted in the form of a cashier's check or money order. All drafts must be payable to TGIF, Inc. and must be payable in US funds. The tournament committee will not refund entry fees after acceptance. Any drafts returned by their respective financial institution will be subject to a \$25.00 fee. The committee will not consider such entries for acceptance until this fee plus the regular entry fee is remitted to the tournament committee.
- 3. Entries must be postmarked by June 13th, 2009 in accordance with USBC Rule 310a-2. No applications will be accepted with a postmark after June 13th, 2009. Entries should be submitted to TGIF Classic, P.O. Box 2532, Indianapolis, IN 46206-2532 or via web entry form at www.tgif-classic.org.
- 4. All prize monies collected as a portion of the tournament entry fee will be returned 100% as tournament payouts. The prize to participant ratio will be a minimum 1 in 8.
- Teams will consist of four bowlers. Priority in scheduling will be given to entries with full four-person teams. A bowler may bowl only once in each event. Doubles pairings may only be made from within a bowler's own team.
- Handicaps will be calculated at 100% of 230 less the bowler's average. Entering averages will be determined as follows:
 - Bowler's highest Fall/Winter/Spring 2008-2009 sanctioned league average as of April 15, 2009 (minimum 21 games).
 - b. If no 2008-2009 average exists, bowler's highest Fall/Winter/Spring sanctioned league average for the 2007-2008 season (minimum 21 games).
 - c. If neither exists, a sanctioned summer league from 2008 (minimum 21 games) will be used.
 - d. If none of the above applies, the bowler will enter with a 230 average.
 - e. Sanctioned league average verification must be submitted with all entries. The verification must be signed by the secretary or other league officer if the secretary is unavailable, and it must contain that officer's area code and telephone number or email address. In accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3, the bowler is responsible for his/her own average verification.
- 7. Any bowler having participated in 21 or more tournament games within the 12 months prior to May 15, 2009 must submit all tournament scores pursuant to USBC rule 319e. Any tournament scores not reported, otherwise falsified, or altered, will cause the bowler to be disqualified from participation in TGIF Classic, and any prize monies won and entry fees paid will be forfeited. The bowler's tournament average will be used for any bowler who has bowled 21 or more tournament games within the 12 months prior to May 15, 2009 if the bowler's tournament average exceeds their highest league average by 10 pins (rule 6 above).
- 8. Any bowler having won \$300 or more in a single event in a tournament within the 12 months prior to May 15, 2009 must submit winnings information with their application pursuant to USBC rule 319d. Failure to report this information will result in disqualification and forfeiture of any prize monies won during the competition and entry fees paid.
- 9. Two practice balls per lane will be permitted prior to the start of each event. Late bowlers will start bowling in the frame in which they arrive, with prior frames scored as zero. Substitutes will be allowed to participate at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- 10. Bowlers will not be allowed practice on their assigned lanes on their scheduled day of bowling. All games will be hosted at Western Bowl, Indianapolis, Indiana.
- 11. All claims of error in scoring must be submitted in writing to the tournament Director within 24 hours after the bowler or team has completed bowling. In any matter of dispute, the tournament guided by USBC rule 329 will have final judgment and jurisdiction.
