RULES FOR THE 2012 MISS TGIF PAGEANT

(KEEP THIS PAGE FOR YOUR INFORMATION)

1. All contestants must check-in at Talbott Street on the evening of Friday, March 23, 2012, no later than 7:00PM, and ready to go on stage at 8:00PM. You may arrive as early as 6:00PM.
2. All contestants must have their music on a LABELED CD. One CD for talent, and one (should you win) for a ballad after the crowning ceremony.
3. All contestants must provide their CD containing their music to the Event Coordinator by 7:30PM on Friday, March 23, 2012. Contestants who fail to provide their CD by the designated time will **NOT** be permitted to perform in the Talent Category.
4. Each contestant is allowed only **one (1)** assistant in the dressing area. Please ask all others to remain in the main bar area.
5. The dispensing of any illegal drug is forbidden. Any contestant in violation will be disqualified.
6. Any theft of other acts deemed to be demeaning to the Miss TGIF title, or the TGIF Classic, will result in disqualification.
7. Politeness and courtesy to fellow contestants, judges, Talbott Street staff, and pageant officials is expected.
8. All contestants will be required to sign a waiver of responsibility to Talbott Street.
9. Any contestant that cannot be at an appointed place at the appointed time may be disqualified for that category.
10. All contestants will be required to donate their tips to the Miss TGIF pageant fundraiser.
11. All contestants must have reached the age of 21 prior to the date of the pageant. Contestants will be required to show a valid State Issued Photo ID prior to competing.
12. Contestants must be a registered USBC, and IGBO league bowler of the current year.
13. Prior Miss TGIF winners are excluded from competing.
14. Judging will be on a total point system. In the event of a tie, the highest score in the talent portion of the pageant will be used to break the tie. In the event of a tie, and the contestants' scores in the talent portion are equal, the contestant receiving the most tips will be used to break the final tie. Contestants will be judged in four (4) categories:
 1. Talent
 2. Tips received during the talent portion of the pageant
 3. Question and Answer
 4. Creative Fashion Wear
15. Any rules not covered by the above will be determined by the Event Coordinator and/or the TGIF Executive Board.
